

Commercial CNG sale begins on trial run basis at Neemrana

Jaipur: Rajasthan State Gas Ltd (RSGL), a joint venture between GAIL Gas Ltd and Rajasthan State Mines and Minerals Ltd (RSMML), on Monday started commercial sale of CNG on trial basis at Neemrana. On the first day, the mega retail outlet witnessed hundred of vehicles plying on the route availing the facility.

"We expect more and more vehicles to use the facility in the coming days. The CNG facility at Neemrana on NH-8 will also meet the demand for gas by the industrial units in the Ghiloth ceramic zone," said Ravi Agarwal, managing director of RSGL.

RSGL had signed an agreement during Resurgent Rajasthan with the state government to invest Rs 2,700 crore to develop gas and pipeline infrastructure in the



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state.

Agarwal said the company is now planning to set up feeder stations on Kota-Jaipur and Kota-Baran-Dewas-Mumbai corridors to provide the clean energy to households, commercial and business entities.

Kota already has the gas pipeline infrastructure and some households are using piped gas. But the project needs fresh impetus. The asset was transferred to RSGL from GAIL to speed up the retail activity which is expected to start from next month, added Agarwal.
