RSGL formalises pact with IOC for CNG gas stations

aipur: After commissioning a CNG station at Neemrana and a daughter booster centre at Kukas to lay out a green corridor, Rajasthan State Gas Ltd (RSGL) on Wednesday formalized an agreement with the Indian Oil Corporation (IOC) signed in May to set up CNG stations at the fuel retailer's outlets in Rajasthan.

After signing the deal, Ravi Agarwal, managing director of Rajasthan State Gas Ltd (RSGL) said three outlets of the IOC has been identified for retailing of CNG.

"Initially, we have selected the locations along the Jaipur-Delhi National Highway-8 for three outlets where CNG will be available. These facilities

will be operational by February next year," said Agarwal.

Sources said the agreement signed in the presence of Aparna Arora, state secretary for mines and petroleum takes into details like marketing margins that both the companies would share.

Unavailability of gas has been a major hurdle in attracting industries to the state, especially in sectors like ceramic where Rajasthan enjoys natural advantage.
